### Pájaro Dunes Garbage

At some point during your visit to Pájaro Dunes you will want to dispose of garbage and recycling. Here is the scoop about what and where.

Single Family Homes—most homes have underground garbage containers usually located on one side of the house. We ask that you use one of these containers for recycling.

Pelican and Cypress units will find garbage corrals in the parking lots near their homes. Recycling containers are located near the garbage enclosures

Overflow garbage can be taken to the fenced yard west of the Gatehouse.

**ONLY Residential garbage is permitted in these areas - absolutely no yard waste or construction debris. This is because the garbage from these areas is taken to a compactor and the compactor can only process regular garbage.**

### Pájaro Dunes Recycling Recycles

Recyclables such as **paper, cardboard, aluminum, glass, plastic, and tin** can be mixed. Please keep in mind that someone has to pull out anything that you put in one of the underground garbage cans, so keep the load light. If you have a lot of bottles, please take them to the recycling bin in the fenced area west of the Gatehouse. Santa Cruz County does not recycle **Styrofoam**.

Pájaro Dunes Maintenance is not licensed to haul hazardous materials, therefore we are prohibited from taking **paints** and the like to the landfill. However, homeowners can take up to 5 gallons of paint to the Buena Vista landfill for free. You will need something that demonstrates that you own property in Santa Cruz County. Staff can assist you in removing appliances, but we will charge for time and pass the fees from the landfill on to you.

### YARD WASTE

Because we want to encourage homeowners to keep up their yards we will pick up a couple of garbage bags full of yard waste several times per year from each homeowner without charge. We ask that you bag your greens, leave them by a roadway and notify the Gatehouse at 831 761 7744.

We will also pick up yard waste the weekend of the annual meeting in May.
